
Introducing Robert 2026 Youth of the Year

This year, Robert, a senior at Hart High School, was selected by staff and the Board. Raised by a single mother who relied on the Club's support, he first joined the Club at 7 years old after watching his older brother attend for years. Now a leader amongst his peers, Robert has built confidence and skills through the Leaders in Training and Mentors in Training programs, has advocated for the Club in Sacramento, and leads tours. He plans to attend College of the Canyons in the Fall then transferring to Virginia Tech.
